COUNCIL UPSKILL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT STAFF

Council have continued training and upskilling staff in emergency management positions.

Last month twenty-five Council staff completed comprehensive Emergency Relief Centre (ERC) operation training, making a total of 50 personnel trained to operate Emergency Relief Centres.

Two additional staff have been trained in Municipal Emergency Management Officer (MEMO) positions, for a total of five trained MEMOs; and two additional staff have undergone Municipal Recovery Managers (MRM) training, for a total of 5 trained MRMs.

Four staff have been trained as Emergency Management Liaison Officers (EMLOs), who, in the event of an emergency, can be deployed to the region's three Incident Control Centres: Ararat, Ballarat and Horsham.

This training is part of Council's commitment to emergency preparation and our community's safety.

The Australian Open, the Rotary Club of Malvern and the Tennis Club of Pomonal have joined forces to offer 10 women from Pomonal the opportunity to attend the Australian Open on Monday 13 January 2025.

Each package will include a Ground Pass, V/Line train tickets to and from Ararat Station, and \$40 spending money.
