This Sunday Willaura Recreation Reserve will host the Willaura Outdoor Market, a boutique market and charity event run by the Willaura Health Care Auxiliary with funds raised going towards improving the lives of residents and patients at Willaura Health Care (East Grampians Health Service).

AUTUMN FIREWOOD COLLECTION SEASON BEGINS

Firewood for personal use can be collected from designated collection areas in State forests during autumn and spring. The autumn collection season begins on March 1 and ends on 30 June, 2025.

People who rely on firewood as their sole source of heating and cooking are strongly encouraged to plan their firewood needs early, ensure they are using firewood in the most efficient way possible, and explore all energy options.


There are serious penalties for failing to follow firewood collection rules.
