UPCOMING PASTURE RECOVERY WORKSHOP

ESSENTIAL WATER REPLACEMENT

Landholders whose water supply has been affected by CFA/FFM use are encouraged to fill out an Essential Water Replacement form and submit to DEECA's Emergency Recovery team. A copy of the form is attached to this newsletter, and details of how to submit are included in the document.

GRAMPIANS NATIONAL PARK RECLOSED

The State Control Centre has declared Grampians (Gariwerd) National Park must close after a series of new bushfires began in unburnt areas of the park on Monday following dry lightning strikes.

The park closure will be enforced for visitor and community safety, and will help emergency services to act quickly.

Members of the public are reminded they may encounter fire crews and heavy machinery on roads and tracks. Please take care and drive safely.
