MOYSTON WORKSHOP BRINGS COMMUNITY IDEAS TOGETHER

The first of five Community Emergency Management Planning workshops, coordinated by Council with support from Emergency Management Victoria, has seen a very successful launch in Moyston.

The 22 attendees showed their enthusiasm in coming together as a community, to support each other before, during and after disasters.

They participated in a series of activities in which groups identified and discussed a range of objectives to improve community outcomes following future disasters.

Many attendees expressed thanks for the seminar's predecessor, an information session also facilitated by Emergency Management specialists The Six C's, which was conducted before Christmas. Household fire plans were changed with many choosing to leave early, had an improved understanding of what to expect, and were confident in interpreting warnings, alerts and advice from VicEmergency.

The Moyston cohort will meet again on 27 March to further progress their group plan.

TELSTRA SERVICE INTERRUPTION IN MOYSTON

Next week, Telstra mobile services will be affected across a six-day period in Moyston while the telecommunications company upgrades its mobile base station to bring new 5G coverage to the area.

Telstra mobile customers will receive texts advising of the upcoming work.

Landline services, NBN internet services, and mobile coverage from other providers will not be impacted.

The following periods will be impacted:

MONDAY 10 FEB - FRIDAY 14 FEB No Telstra mobile coverage.

The Telstra network will be restored at the end of the day on Friday.

SATURDAY 15 FEB

Some Telstra network interruptions duing the day.

These interruptions will be due to call testing and integration of the mobile network.

Telstra also encourages business owners talk to their bank about connecting their EFTPOS terminals to their NBN or Wi-Fi connection to prevent delays in processing transactions.
