## AUTUMN FIREWOOD COLLECTION SEASON BEGINS

Firewood for personal use can now be collected from designated collection areas in State forests during autumn and spring. The autumn collection season begins on March 1 and ends on 30 June, 2025.

People who rely on firewood as their sole source of heating and cooking are strongly encouraged to plan their firewood needs early, ensure they are using firewood in the most efficient way possible, and explore all energy options.

There are serious penalties for failing to follow firewood collection rules.
